area. He would like to have time to contact organizations to see what can be done to preserve it.

Kevin Phelps asked if it was deemed of historical value was Roger asking for Fiscal Court to take it over? Phelps also stated it could open the county up to legal action to preserve it. The Army Corp of Engineers would like to see the county to take ownership of the dam. Allen Smith stated that the dam was never planned to be taken out. The funding was left from the removal of Lock 6 and Lock 5. The funding deadline is fast approaching and could run out by the end of summer. The issues was tabled until the next Fiscal Court meeting.

The City of Rochester asked the Fiscal Court to release the money set aside for a pavilion, previously not need by the city, to rebuild the post office which generates income for Rochester. The \$6,508 would help to repair damages. The issues was tabled until financial documents could be provided. This is common practice for the Fiscal Court.

Fiscal Court approved the 2024 Property franchise mineral tax settlement and 2024

Property franchise mineral tax settlement pending final audit.

The road department was asked if they would be interested in purchasing the rented pug mill. Fiscal Court decided to make a offer of \$6,500. If accepted the County could recoup this money in 6 years on chip and seal roads.

The ferry houses bid was awarded to George Burrow for labor. The County will purchase materials. The Fiscal Court approved the 25/26 pay schedule, to add Chris Phelps also and with the exceptions of Michelle Duvall and Marty Jones who receive a cost of living through the administration code and back pay to February of 2025.

5th district chip and seal was approved in the amount of \$35,745.

Fiscal Court voted to removed Angela Pendley at treasurer effective June 30, 2025 replace with Drema Nicewater effective July1, 2025. remove Angela Pendley from Morgantown Bank and Trust signature card and replace with Drema Nicewater.

Fiscal Court approved the following; to pay 1/2 of insurance premiums before

fiscal year ends, litter abatement payments all bills and transfers, approve 25/26 pay schedule with the exceptions of Michelle and Marty Duvall, to surplus 2005 Chevrolet Silverado, pay the Board of Assessment appeals, 2025 spay/neuter grant, to pay the 2022-23 audit in the amount of \$11,625, to repair the 6330 John Deer Tractor, and second reading of the 2025-26 budget.

Dillon Bryant gave \$317 to Gilstrap Community Center remodel.

Fiscal Court was then adjourned. the next Fiscal Court will be July 14, 2025 at 5:00 pm in the upstairs courtroom.

Butler County Property Court was held immediately after Fiscal Court. This meeting was about the new judicial center. In Judicial Center updates: Meetings will be held quarterly after Fiscal Court for the rest of 2025. The construction start date was set March 2, 2026 with a end date of December 1, 2027. The monthly treasures settlement was approved. A new treasure, Drema Nicewater, was appointed. Meeting was then adjourned.

stuck ever since.”

The band ultimately kicked off back in 2022 at The Grove and came full circle with the June 21 performance of songs from the new album, a day after its release.

“We hope this album takes us to a position where we can do this full time, and in order to do what we love

to do, we hope to get to that place where we can solely focus on creating music,” Crowder said. “As confident and proud as we are of this record lasting a long time, we are going to start on album #2 very soon.”
