Residents and visitors alike are invited for an unforgettable celebration on July 4 at the Barren River Lake State Park. Fireworks will begin at 9:00 p.m. for a stunning patriotic display that will light up the skies over the lake.

However, the traditional celebration will not include the family day at the beach due to the recent flooding, which has both the beach and beach parking areas underwater.

Spectators can watch the fireworks from

the park on the grassy hill behind the State Park Lodge and around the tennis courts. Boaters are welcome to anchor offshore near the beach, outside the designated fireworks safety zone. As a reminder, all boat lights should be operational and keep a lookout for floating debris.

Flooding in the area has resulted in the loss of 250 beach parking spaces. Friends of Barren River Lake encourage individuals to carpool, if possible, arrive early to se-

cure a good spot, use designated parking areas and be prepared for a short walk, and abide by the no-parking zones and marked areas in the park. Lawn chairs and blankets are allowed.

Patrons can enjoy dinner at Driftwood Restaurant or from a local food truck before the show begins.
