

McGinnis named CLE Commission chair

ASHLAND The Kentucky Supreme Court appointed a local attorney as chairman of the Continuing Legal Education Commission.

Stephen McGinnis, representing the Seventh Supreme Court District, has served on the commission since July 1, 2023.

The CLE Commission consists of seven attorneys, including McGinnis.

Others are Jennifer Nelson (First District), Colton Givens (Second), Kelly Ridings (Third), Megan Keane (Fourth), Nealy Williams (Fifth) and Frank Tremper (Sixth).

Justice Robert Conley is the Supreme Court Liaison.

The commission's duties include encouraging, promoting, conducting and sponsoring high-quality continuing legal education, encouraging/promoting

quality legal writing, establishing standards, procedures and forms to evaluate applications, report to the board and the court on the status of continuing

legal education in Kentucky and submitting budgets.

McGinnis said the commission is respon-

sible for ensuring all attorneys complete requirement hours and for reviewing courses to make sure they're appropriate to receive CLE credit. The commission also approves or denies requests for people who write scholarly articles for credit.

"I have always loved helping lawyers," McGinnis said. "I want to thank the Supreme Court for appointing me."

McGinnis served on the KBA Ethics Commit-

tee for 10 years as an ethics hotline attorney.

He will serve a term ending June 30, 2026, as chair. He is also a candidate for the board of governors for the bar association. If he is named to that board, he will transfer off of the CLE Commission, he said.

McGinnis is a partner at McGinnis Leslie PLLC. He practices law in Greenup and Ashland. He's also the city attorney for several cities in Greenup and Lewis

Counties.

McGinnis, who graduated from the University of Kentucky's law school in 1994, is married to local attorney Tracy Frye.

He was recently featured in Kentucky Bench & Bar Magazine following his CLE appointment.
