Branch Bak Approved at Garrison.
Today Sterling Moore, Chief Executive Office of the Citizens-Deposit bank, announced that

Federal Deposit Insurance Company, an Agency of the Federal Government, insuring the safety of customer deposits up to \$40,000 in commercial banks through out the U.S. has granted its approval for a branch office of the Citizens Deposit Bank, in Vanceburg and one in Garrison, Ky. This concludes all the necessary approval for the operation of a fully insured, full service, banking facility in both Vanceburg and Garrison. As previously announced the bank already owned a location North of Ky. #10 and East of Vanceburg Post Office with tentative plans for a drive-in facility there. Citizens-Deposit recently acquired 2.4 acres of land from G.W. and Goldie Appelgate in Garrison. Plans are being considered to open a temporary office in Garrison until a satisfactory permanent building is designed and constructed.
