Ordinance 25-1431 amending the Fleming County budget Fiscal Year 2025-2026, to include unanticipated receipts from General, Road, Jail, LG&A, Forest Fire, Opoid, Dispatch, Clerks Storage, ABC, and Capital Improvement Funds totaling \$771,278.28 with offsetting appropriations in Reserve for Transfer was adopted by the Fleming County Fiscal Court at the August 12, 2025 meeting. RESOLUTION 25-1433

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE LEVY AND ADOPTION OF TAX RATES FOR FLEMING COUNTY, AND ACCEPTANCE OF TAX RATES FOR SPECIAL DISTRICTS AND OTHER TAXING DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the Fleming County Fiscal Court on August 12, 2025, determined the tax rates necessary to produce sufficient revenues for the operation of county government and services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

Section One: There is levied for the year 2025 the general ad valorem tax rates per \$100.00 of assessed value of all taxable property within the jurisdiction of the Fleming County Fiscal Court as follows:

- (A) Real Estate 14.50 cents per \$100
- (B) Tangible Personal 14.50 cents per \$100
- (C) Motor Vehicle & Watercraft 16 cents per \$100
- (D) Inventory in Transit 0.0 cents per \$100

Section Two: The Fleming County Fiscal Court hereby approves the tax rates of assessed valuation as set forth below for each Special District or other taxing district:

Section Three: The Fleming County Treasurer shall cause this resolution to be published in the Flemingsburg “Gazette” within thirty (30) days after adoption.

Section Four: Prior to making expenditures which have not been previously budgeted from unanticipated income, the budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 shall be amended as provided by KRS 68.280.

Section Five: The resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
