Please be advised that Boyle County Judge/Executive Trille Bottom will hold a public hearing at Danville City Hall, 445 W. Main St., Danville KY 40422 beginning at 4:00 PM Eastern Daylight Time on August 5, 2025, for the purpose of receiving public comment on the creation of a water commission among members including the Cities of Broadhead, Crab Orchard, Danville, Lancaster, Mt. Vernon, and Stanford, McKinney Water District, and Western Rockcastle Water Association. Under Kentucky law, a water commission has the ability to purchase or construct sources of supply of water and operate them jointly. Customers of these water utilities would still continue to receive water service from their utility provider, even if the water commission is established. A water commission can be created if there is a finding that the establishment of the commission is reasonably necessary or advantageous for the public health, convenience, and comfort of the customers of all the water systems which proposed the creation of the commission. The Kentucky Department for Local Development is accepting application materials under the 2025 HUD Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The Fiscal Court of Garrard County intends to apply for financial assistance for the purpose of constructing a food bank. The project is planned for 417 Industry Road, Lancaster, KY 40444.

The Garrard County Fiscal Court will hold a public hearing prior to the submission of its HUD CDBG CP application. The public hearing will be held at 5:00 PM on August 7, 2025 at the Garrard County Courthouse located at 15 Public Square, Lancaster, KY 40444.

The purpose of the HUD CDBG CP public hearing is to obtain views of the public on housing and community development needs, review proposed activities, review the proposed application, and solicit public comments. For the HUD CDBG application, technical assistance is available to help groups representing low and moderate income persons in developing proposals.

The following information concerning the CDBG program is available for public inspection at the office of the Judge/Executive during regular business hours:

A. Amount of funds available under the HUD program and the permissible range of activities.
B. Estimated amounts of funds proposed to be used for activities benefiting persons of low and moderate income.
C. Plans for minimizing displacement of persons as a result of activities associated with CDBG funds and plans for providing assistance to those persons to be actually displaced as a result of CDBG-funded activities.
D. Records regarding the past use of CDBG funds.
E. A summary of other important program requirements.

Comments on Application

A copy of the CDBG application material will be on file at the office of the Judge/Executive for citizens' review and comment during regular business hours from July 25, 2025 to August 7, 2025. Comments on the proposed application may be submitted to the attention of Judge Elleman, 15 Public Square, Suite 3, Lancaster, KY 40444 until 5:00 PM on August 7, 2025.
