



Garrard Girls Golf Team Continues To Improve

The Garrard girls' golf team continued its upward trajectory with a run of three consecutive top-three team results in August, highlighted by a first-place individual finish from Abigail Travis at the team's home event.

On August 6, Garrard placed second overall, led by Travis in second place, Kylee

Kobernick in third, and Katie Sharp in ninth. The balanced showing put three Cardinals inside the top 10 and set the tone for the week ahead.

Five days later at Bright Leaf Golf Resort on August 11, the team secured third place. Travis again paced Garrard with another runner-up finish, while Kobernick added a sixth-place result to keep the team on the podium.

Garrard capped the stretch with another third-place team performance at its home match at Peninsula Golf Resort, marking three straight top-three finishes. Travis earned medalist honors with a 45, and Kobernick finished in a tie for seventh as the Cardinals maintained their consistency against regional competition.

Across the three events, Travis delivered finishes of second, second, and first to anchor Garrard's lineup, while Kobernick posted top-10 results in each start. The series underscores the team's steady form as the season progresses and positions Garrard to build on its momentum in upcoming tournaments.

Garrard Boys Golf Edges Southwestern Pulaski By Three Strokes On Aug. 19

Garrard boys golf opened the week with a narrow victory over Southwestern Pulaski on Tuesday, posting a team score of 182 to the Warriors' 185. The three-stroke margin proved decisive in a match that remained competitive throughout.

Garrard's lineup was led by the steady play of Korbin Folger, Gabe Doolin, Jake Steffen, and Pearce Molen. The quartet provided the core scoring that separated the Golden Lions in a tight contest, with consistent work around the greens helping Garrard protect its advantage down the stretch.

The win gives Garrard a measure of early momentum as the schedule intensifies. With Folger, Doolin, Steffen, and Molen

setting the pace, the Golden Lions will look to build on Tuesday's performance.

Garrard will now turn attention to its next outing, aiming to carry forward the consistency shown by its leaders and convert close margins into repeat results as the season progresses.
