The Williamstown track team put up strong performances during an indoor meet at Centre College on Saturday.

Starting with the girls results in the 1600 Meter, Cameron Reynolds clocked a personal best time of 5:59.37, placing 10th.

Annabelle Brooks finished 20th with a time of 6:37.12, while Brooklynn Dills followed closely in 21st with a time of 6:38.07.

In the 800 Meter Harper Mann earned a 10th place finish with a time of 2:39.72.

For the 4x800 Meter Relay the team of Bianca Dills, Mann, Cameron, and Annabelle Brooks finished in 5th place with a time of 11:41.04.

For boys, the 800 Meter Aaron Reynolds finished 15th out of 37 runners with a time of 2:20.77.

In the 1600 Meter, William Osborne placed 20th with a time of 5:23.35.

In the Shot Put area Zach Mirones earned 8th place with a throw of 34-5.
