**Caal-Garcia's motion sustained, jury trial set for Aug. 26**

The man charged in a motor vehicle accident that claimed the lives of two Marion County residents appeared in Marion Circuit Court Division 1 on Aug. 7.

Franklin Otoniel Caal-Garcia, 19, of 372 Lake Avenue, had his motion to inspect the phone in evidence sustained by Judge Todd Spalding. Spalding then set a pretrial conference date of Aug. 25 at 9:00 a.m. and a jury trial for Aug. 26 at 8:30 a.m.

Caal-Garcia's original trial was scheduled to start on June 30, but Spalding remanded that date due to the Kentucky State Police not having completed the accident reconstruction report. At that time, he set the case for review on June 26, and at that time, KSP had submitted its report.

On Nov. 2, 2024, KSP Post 15 troopers responded to a two-vehicle collision on US 68 around 6:30 p.m. near the intersection of Jessietown Road. A 2005 Dodge Ram, driven by Garcia, was traveling west on US 68 when he crossed the centerline of the roadway, entered the east-bound lane, and dropped off the roadway. Garcia steered his vehicle back into the eastbound lane and collided head-on with a 2020 Chevrolet Equinox, driven by Roy Wright, 75, of Lebanon. Wright and his wife, Deborah Wright, 72, who was pronounced dead at the scene, while Roy Wright later died at the University of Kentucky Hospital.

At the time, he gave police

his name as Erick Alonzo Garcia. He was indicted by a Marion County Grand Jury for two counts of vehicular homicide while under the influence of alcohol (Class B felony), theft of identity of another without consent (Class D felony), operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol/substances, first offense-aggravator (Class B misdemeanor), careless driving (violation), and failure to produce an insurance card (violation).

Caal-Garcia is lodged in the Marion County Detention Center on a \$2 million bond.

Garrett Bryant pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the following charges: First-degree possession of a controlled substance, first offense-methamphetamine (3 years pretrial diverted for 3 years), failure of owner to maintain the required insurance/security, first offense (45 days probated for 6 months), operating a motor vehicle under the influence of substances, first offense (30 days probated for 1 year), and license to be in possession (45 days probated for 6 months).

Mikayla Cross pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the following charges: Third-degree burglary-amended from second-degree burglary (1 year pretrial diverted for 5 years), first-degree criminal mischief (1 year pretrial diverted for 5 years), and theft by unlawful taking or disposition all others \$1,000 but under \$10,000 (1 year pretrial diverted for 5 years). She must pay restitution of \$5,695.25

at the rate of \$100 per month beginning on Oct. 1. The case can be dismissed/diverted when the restitution is paid in full.

Tyranie Guyton pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the following charge: Assault under extreme emotional disturbance, amended from second-degree assault (1 year pretrial diverted for 2 years).

April Nalley pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the following charges: Fraudulent insurance acts \$500 but less than \$10,000-amended from fraudulent insurance acts \$10,000 or more but less than \$1 million (3 years probated for 5 years), and theft of identity of another without consent (3 years probated for 5 years). She must and pay restitution of \$10,743.77 at the rate of \$180 a month with co-defendant beginning Oct. 1. Her final sentencing is set for Sept. 4 at 9:00 a.m.

Richard Chad Tate pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the follow charges: First-degree possession of a controlled substance, first offense-cocaine (2 years pretrial diverted for 3 years), drug paraphernalia-buy possess (12 months probated for 24 months), and operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol .08, second offense (30 days probated for 24 months) and 120 day license suspension.

Elaine Hancock pleaded guilty and was sentenced on the following charges: First-degree wanton endangerment (1 year pretrial diverted for 2 years), and fourth-degree assault, no visible injury (12 months probated for 24 months).

A man charged with possession of methamphetamine was sentenced in Marion Circuit Court Division 2 on Aug. 7, just one of several individuals facing drug charges to appear in court on that date.

Christopher Wood pleaded guilty to first-degree possession of a controlled substance (methamphetamine), to which Judge Kaelin Reed sentenced him to 1 year pretrial diversion

for 2 years; drug paraphernalia-buy/possess (12 months probated for 24 months), and public intoxication controlled substances-excludes alcohol (45 days probated for 6 months). He also had a DCPT set for Aug. 5, 2027, at 1:00 p.m.

Larvana Boblitt pleaded guilty and was sentenced to 12 months probated for 24 months on a charge of second-degree possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia-buy/possess. She was sentenced to 45 days probated for 6 months on the

charge of possession of marijuana.
