Purpose:

The purpose of this meeting is to present information and gather input on the planning phase for the proposed Morgan County Waste & Recycling Center, to be located on a previously disturbed surface mine site at 1169 Highway 172 in West Liberty, Kentucky.

This project, funded through the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) Mini-Flex Grant Program, supports the initial engineering and planning of a new solid waste transfer and recycling facility. The proposed facility will replace the County’s outdated transfer station, improving solid waste management efficiency, environmental protection, and public health.

The project represents the first step in a larger effort to modernize Morgan County’s waste infrastructure, enhance sustainability, and prepare for future construction of a fully operational center. A brief presentation will be followed by an open discussion, and a public input survey will be provided to collect feedback on community needs and site considerations.
