In accordance with KRS 350:055, notice is hereby given that ICG East Kentucky, LLC, Route 17, P.O. Box E, Sharples, WV 25183, has applied for renewal of a permit for an existing surface coal mining and reclamation operation located 0.19 miles east of Nolan, West Virginia in Pike and Martin Counties. The operation disturbs 1,277.94 surface acres.

The proposed operation is approximately 2.1 miles southeast from SR-292's junction with Stepp Branch Road and is located along Mount Sterling Branch of Tug Fork.

The operation is located on the Naugatuck and Williamson U.S.G.S. 7 1/2-minute quadrangle maps. The operation will use the surface area removal methods of surface mining. The surface area is owned by ICG East Kentucky, LLC.

The application has been filed for public inspection at the Division Mining Reclamation and Enforcement's Pikeville Regional Office, 121 Mays Branch Rd., Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.
