The greenhouse was put up on Dec. 18, 2024, and the chapter raised their first crop of plants soon after. Caroline Mattingly, a senior and outgoing chapter president, was excited to see the project come to fruition before

her graduation. “I remember freshman year, me and Mrs. Celisa, and a bunch of us, all of us were sitting in the classroom with a whiteboard, and we were just dreaming of what it would be like to have one,” said Mattingly. “It was really special to see this year to like, actually see it grow and become like an official greenhouse

The final question of the night went to the county officials. The question asked if any new economic development projects were being worked on, and what a five year projection may look like. Spraggs said several projects were being discussed, but were currently only being discussed in

executive session due to confidentiality and being in the early stages of development. Collins also noted that the county is “just as aggressive” as other counties in the area, and many projects are being worked on behind the scenes at all times. Darnall also echoed that many projects are happening in closed sessions. He noted that there is one project in particular he thinks is “really

cool” but that the details cannot be made public at this time. Spraggs also noted that the county is often working to upgrade and increase the infrastructure in the county, but that county also spends ample time maintaining the existing infrastructure. The town hall event is an annual event, but also serves as a candidate forum during election years.
