Barren County Board of Education Required Legal Notice

The Barren County Board of Education is proposing a general fund tax levy of 62.6 cents on real property and 67.4 cents on personal property.

The General Fund tax levied in fiscal year 2026 was 62.6 cents on real property and 67.4 cents on personal property and produced revenue of \$13,588,776.72. The proposed General Fund tax rate of 62.6 cents on real property and 67.4 cents on personal property is expected to produce \$15,093,045.01. Of this amount, \$1,891,629.13 is from new and personal property. The compensating tax for 2027 is 60.2 cents on real property and 67.3 cents on personal property and is expected to produce \$14,570,575.61.

The proposed rate is expected to generate more revenue than received in the preceding year. The general areas to which revenue of \$1,504,268.29 above 2026 revenue is to be allocated are as follows: Cost of collections, \$41,367; building fund, \$100,000; instruction, \$1,000,000; transportation, \$200,000; and maintenance of plant, \$162,901.29.

This information is published pursuant to KRS 160.470. The proposed tax rate is not subject to recall under KRS 132.017.

A Message from the Chief Financial Officer (Not part of the required legal notice listed above)

The Board is proposing to keep the school tax rate the same as last year. This is not a rate increase.

The revenue figure in the notice above (\$15,093,045) is what the rate would produce if every tax bill were paid in full, which state law requires us to publish. In practice the district collects about 96 percent of what is billed, so we expect to actually receive approximately \$14,489,323.

Because property values in the county rose this year, the state reduces the district's SEEK funding by an estimated \$484,195.80. When local property values go up, the state sends us less, so keeping the rate steady simply helps the district hold its ground.

Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos Energy") intends to proposed revisions to its tariff extending its Gas Cost Performance Ratemaking Mechanism ("PBR") on file with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") by applying for an extension for five years with the Commission on or after August 31, 2026 in Case No. 2026-00224. The tariff filing will request the proposed revisions become effective October 1, 2026.

Atmos Energy intends to propose an extension of five years to its PBR mechanism revising Sheet No. 18 of its Commission-approved tariff until May 31, 2032. Atmos Energy is also proposing updates to the tier ratios. Atmos Energy believes the PBR has been a benefit to its customers and its shareholders. The PBR mechanism is explained in detail in Sheets Nos. 18-29 of its tariff and Atmos Energy is not requesting that it be revised other than the tier ratios.
