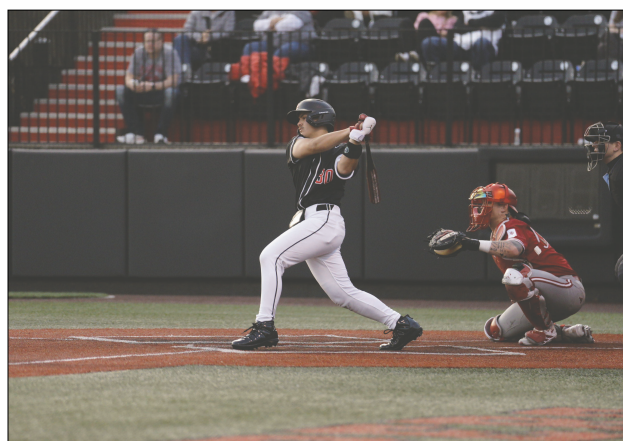

# Tops earn twin-bill split with Indiana

Western Kentucky's baseball team continued its four-game weekend series hosting Indiana with a doubleheader split on Saturday at Nick Denes Field. The Hilltoppers opened the day with a 3-1 loss to the Hoosiers before returning for Game 2 of the doubleheader and securing a 14-12 victory.

With the split, WKU moves to 7-5 overall and takes a 2-1 lead in the series with Indiana.

WKU's offense was

limited to four hits in the opener, with Hayden

Robbins' homer providing the only extra-base knock. Robertson's performance on the mound highlighted the afternoon for the Tops – the lefty has now totaled 16 innings pitched for WKU through three starts and currently holds a 1.69 ERA.

Lane Arroyos fueled the WKU offense with a 3-for-3 performance in the nightcap, scoring four runs and reaching base five times. JP Acosta also went 3-for-3 at the plate, scoring three runs. Kyle

Hayes drove in three runs on the night, while Hayden Nazareus added a two-RBI homer and two RBIs. Conner Wolf provided stability out of the bullpen, throwing 2 1/3 innings with four strikeouts while allowing just two hits and no earned runs.

WKU and IU combined for 26 runs and 28 hits in the nightcap. WKU's pitching staff walked only one batter for the game compared to IU's nine.

WKU was set to wrap up its four-game weekend

series hosting Indiana on Sunday at Nick Denes Field.

# Wildcats knock off No. 25 Vanderbilt 91-77

LEXINGTON — Collin Chandler scored a career-high 23 points to lead Kentucky to a 91-77 win over No. 25 Vanderbilt on Saturday.

Otegha Oweh also had 23 points for Kentucky (19-10 overall, 10-6 Southeastern Conference), which split the regular-season series after losing to the Commodores 80-55 on Jan. 27 in Nashville. The Wildcats notched their second straight victory after dropping three straight to

Florida, Georgia and Auburn earlier this month.

Tyler Tanner led the Commodores (22-9, 9-7) with 19 points, followed by Jalen Washington with 16. Tyler Nickel had 13, AK Okereke scored 12 and Duke Miles had 11.

Chandler tied a career high with six 3-pointers and Kentucky which finished with 11 in the game. He had five of the Wildcats' seven in the first half for 15 points.

Chandler connected on back-to-back 3s and

scored six of the first eight points for the Wildcats. Kentucky used a 7-0 run to build a double-digit lead, which it maintained throughout the game.

Kentucky led 46-31 at the break and increased the margin to 89-67 with 3:05 remaining.

Denzel Aberdeen had 15 points for Kentucky, making three 3-pointers. The Wildcats managed just 3s in the first meeting.

Kentucky, which had committed 56 turnovers in the previous four games, had just 11, including

three in the opening half. Kentucky is at Texas A&M on Tuesday night.

CLEMSON 80, NO. 24 LOUISVILLE 76

CLEMSON, S.C. — Jestin Porter scored all 16 of his points in the second half as Clemson snapped a four-game losing streak with an 80-76 victory over No. 24 Louisville on Saturday.

The Tigers, once comfortably in the NCAA Tournament field with 10 wins in their first 11 Atlantic Coast Conference games, had raised ques-

tions the past two weeks with their late-season slide. But Clemson (21-8, 11-5 ACC) held off the Cardinals (20-9, 9-7) with defense and Porter's timely baskets.

Up 55-49, Porter drove through the right side of Louisville's defense for a basket off the glass. Moments later, Nick Davidson stole the ball from Adrian Wooley, fed a perfect pass to a wide-open Porter who hit a 3-pointer for a double-digit lead.

Porter, a senior transfer

from Middle Tennessee State, had not scored in double figures in 10 games and, with zero points and two fouls in the first 20 minutes on Saturday, did not appear on pace to break that streak. But Porter made two early shots in the second half before his critical stretch put away the Cardinals.

Wooley had 17 points to lead the Cardinals, who have lost three of their past four.

Louisville hosts Syracuse on Tuesday.
