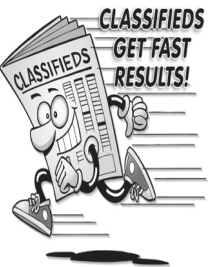

NOTICE

The Edmonson County Board of Education has approved a general fund tax levy of 51.0 cents on real property and 51.0 cents on personal property.

The General Fund tax levied in fiscal year 2026 was 45.9 cents on real property and 45.9 cents on personal property and produced revenue of \$4,854,255.84. The approved General Fund tax rate of 51.0 cents on real property and 51.0 cents on personal property is expected to produce \$5,894,076. Of this amount, \$434,363 is from new and personal property. The compensating tax for 2027 is 44.7 cents on real property and 44.8 cents on personal property and is expected to produce \$5,166,528.45.

The approved rate is expected to generate more revenue than received in the preceding year. The general areas to which revenue of \$1,039,820.16 above 2026 revenue is to be allocated are as follows: Cost of collections, \$25,995.50; building fund, \$723,370; instruction, \$290,454.66.

This information is published pursuant to KRS 160.470. The proposed tax rate is not subject to recall under KRS 132.017.

EDMONSON COUNTY 2026 ADOPTED TAX RATES

The Edmonson County Fiscal Court formally adopts the 2026 tax rates.

The current tax rates are in cents per \$100.00.

Real Property	12.2
Tangible Property	19.5
Motor Vehicle	17.1
Inventory	19.5
Watercraft	17.1
Aircraft	19.5
Bank Shares	20.0

The Edmonson County Fiscal Court held a public hearing on September 10th, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the Edmonson County Courthouse for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The tax rate levied last year was 12.2 and produced revenues in the amount of \$1,269,862.

This year's compensating rate is 11.9 and will produce revenues in the amount \$1,310,545. The Edmonson County Fiscal Court proposed a tax rate of 12.2 which will produce a total of \$1,343,584 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$37,535; revenue expected from Personal Property is \$106,085; revenue expected from Motor Vehicle is \$230,780; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$25,996.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for General Fund utilization for Edmonson County Fiscal Court expenses.

The Kentucky General Assembly requires that the Edmonson County Fiscal Court publish this notice with the above information contained herein.
