The Kentucky Department of Local Government (DLG) is accepting application material under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The City of Flemingsburg, located in Fleming County, intends to apply for assistance to upgrade and repair certain elements of the old Lerman building in downtown Flemingsburg, also known as the Fischer Building Apartments. They city owned building contains housing units and needs upgrades and improvements that may include, but are not limited to, HVAC, roof replacement, energy efficiency, interior renovation, and other such needs.

The City of Flemingsburg will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, January 21, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. at the Flemingsburg City Annex, located at 164 Newman Park Way, Flemingsburg, KY 41041. The purpose of this hearing is to obtain views on housing and community development needs, review proposed activities, review the proposed application, and solicit public comments. Technical assistance is available to help groups representing low- and moderate-income persons in developing proposals.
