assists and 2.5 rebounds. He came off the bench the previous two years at Florida and averaged 7.7 points as a junior in 2024-25.

Aberdeen's case comes as an NCAA panel is preparing to discuss potential changes to eligibility rules that would include an age limit.

The proposal, which mirrors language written in the executive order issued by

President Donald Trump last week, would give athletes five years of eligibility with the clock starting when an athlete turns 19 or graduates from high school, whichever is earliest. There would be limited exceptions, but they would not include injuries, which has been a common reason for players to ask for and receive extra eligibility.

The details will be reviewed and discussed by the Division I Cabinet next week, but not voted on for implementation, according to two people who spoke to The Associated Press.

The people spoke on condition of anonymity earlier this week because the NCAA hasn't publicly discussed the proposal.

Trump called for "clear, consistent and fair eligibility limits, including a five-year participation window" that limits athletes to one transfer with

one more available once they get a four-year degree.

Speaking at the Final Four over the weekend, NCAA President Charlie Baker said Trump wanted to figure out a way to "get something on the books that works and represents what most people are looking for at this point,

which is a much simpler

eligibility process, which we've

been talking to our committees

about."


