LONDON — Community members and local officials gathered Thursday to celebrate the official opening of NECCO Foster Care's London office with a ribbon-cutting ceremony hosted in partnership with the London-Laurel County Chamber of Commerce.

In a social media post following the event, NECCO London described the occasion as "a special day," adding, "We were honored to celebrate our Ribbon Cutting Ceremony and officially welcome NECCO London to the community."

The organization expressed appreciation to the Chamber for coordinating the event, noting, "A heartfelt thank you to the Laurel County Chamber of Commerce for hosting such a beautiful ceremony and helping make this day so meaningful."

Their new office is located at 725 S. Main St. in London, and is open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday.

NECCO provides a range of services aimed at

supporting at-risk youth and families — including foster care and adoption, counseling, independent living and residential services.

The opening also highlighted the ongoing need for foster families across the region. NECCO officials noted that they serve multiple counties — including Laurel, Clay, Jackson, Leslie, Lee and Owsley — and are actively seeking individuals interested in becoming foster parents.

"There are so many children in need of safe, loving homes," the organization stated in a Facebook post, encouraging community members to get involved.

NECCO representatives also thanked those on Facebook who attended and supported the event, saying, "We are incredibly grateful to everyone who helped make today a success and to all of the community members who came out to show their support."
