Deans, President's Lists announced at MCTC

Dr. Dana Calland, Maysville Community and Technical College's Vice President of Academic Services, has released the Dean's List and the President's Honors List for full and part-time students for the spring 2026 semester.

MCTC offers associate degrees, diplomas, and certificates in over 30 programs of study with classes offered on the Maysville Campus in Mason County, the Licking Valley Campus in Cynthiana, the Montgomery Campus in Mt. Sterling, and the Rowan Campus in Morehead, as well as online.

Students who achieve a 4.0 semester grade point average (GPA) and successfully complete at least 12 credit hours of

coursework numbered 100 or above during an academic term will be recognized on the Full-Time Student President's Honor List. Part-time students earning a 4.0 semester GPA while completing between 3 and 11 credit hours of coursework in a term, and who have accumulated at least 12 KCTCS credit hours of coursework numbered 100 or above, will be eligible for the Part-Time Student President's Honor List.

Students who earn at least a 3.5 semester GPA and successfully complete 12 or more credit hours of coursework numbered 100 or above during an academic term will be included on the Full-Time Student Dean's List. Part-time students who achieve a

minimum 3.5 semester GPA while completing between 3 and 11 credit hours in a term, and who have accumulated at least 12 credit hours of coursework numbered 100 or above, will be recognized on the Part-Time Student Dean's List.

Senator Steve West recognized as 2026 Kentucky Chamber MVP

CHAMBER HIGHLIGHTS WEST'S LEADERSHIP ON EDUCATION, WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AND ENERGY POLICY



Sen. Steve West, R-Paris, has been recognized by the Kentucky Chamber of Commerce as an MVP of the 2026 General Assembly for his leadership advancing workforce-focused education policy

and supporting Kentucky's long-term economic competitiveness.

The Kentucky Chamber specifically recognized West for sponsoring Senate Bill (SB) 4, legislation establishing a statewide professional development program for school principals that incorporates an intensive leadership curriculum developed in partnership with the Kentucky Chamber Foundation. The chamber also highlighted West's work on energy policy as a member of the Energy Planning and Inventory Com-

mission.

"Strong schools and a strong economy go hand in hand," West said. "Kentucky's future workforce is sitting in our classrooms today, and investing in effective school leadership is one of the best ways we can improve student outcomes and prepare the next generation for success. I'm honored to receive this recognition and appreciate the Kentucky Chamber's partnership in helping strengthen education and workforce development across the commonwealth."

As chairman of the Senate Standing Committee on Education, West has been a leading voice on policies designed to improve academic achievement, strengthen accountability and better align education systems with workforce needs.

SB 4 was one of several education initiatives considered during the 2026 legislative session aimed at improving student performance and supporting school leaders. The legislation creates a statewide framework for principal leadership development and seeks to

strengthen educational outcomes through improved school leadership.

In addition to his work on education policy, West has also been active in discussions surrounding Kentucky's energy future and economic competitiveness through his service on the Energy Planning and Inventory Commission.

Kentucky Chamber President and CEO Ashli Watts praised West and other award recipients for helping advance policies that support economic growth and opportunity.

"Throughout the 2026 legislative session, these lawmakers demonstrated leadership in advancing policies that strengthen the commonwealth," Watts said.

"The Kentucky Chamber applauds their work to ensure businesses can grow, communities can thrive and more Kentuckians have the opportunity to succeed."
