nights a week, making maximum use of practice and game spaces.

Hamilton also noted that the City of Morehead now has a new website, which will allow online reservation of any shelter and any facility. He also noted that any deadlines will now be treated as opening and closing windows, and the next set of sign-ups will be for football and soccer.

He also said that a new, bigger playground is planned at Rodburn Park. Hamilton said that the playground proposed beside the Battson-Oates Common had several issues, and the grant funding it would be used at Rodburn. Work was scheduled to begin on the 17th and completed by the end of this month. He said all of the city's four playgrounds are seeing

heavy use, and he said the Friends of Roburn Hollow have been very helpful in dealing with "negative traffick" and trash.

Board member Edna Schack gave an update on the activities of the bicycle ad hoc committee. She said the committee has met twice and includes members Gina Blunt Gonzalez, James, Hood, Tom Kiffmeyer, Rita Watkins, Rodney Watkins, Debbie Neff, and Schack.

Schack said the committee is focusing on identifying issues to improve bicycle use, safety, and mobility in downtown Morehead. The committee identified four main problems: limited infrastructure; lack of clear cycling ordinances; lack of awareness of cycling and regulations; and various safety concerns related to cycling. Some proposals include having an event at Rodburn Park in May during National

Bicycle Month, called the Tour De Morehead, to focus on cycling safety and basics for kids; gathering cycling resources, including maps and routes, signage; and increased community engagement.

Schack said a recent parking study also included identifying pedestrian and cycling areas in Morehead, and Morehead/Rowan County Tourism had done an earlier study in 2018. The committee will meet again on April 20 at 5 p.m. at the Carl Perkins Center.

Committee members noted that there is also heavy use of the Harry T. Clark County Park, located off of KY 801 North. Rob Hamm said he counted about 100 people there last Sunday.

Board member Skip Holley shared information from County Operations Director Dylan Lambert, including that the new playground

equipment is in place, with rubber ground to be installed. The county has advertised a request for qualifications (RFQ) for engineering firms for the proposed amphitheater at the park. A new automated gate has been installed at the park, which automatically opens at 6 a.m. and closes 30 minutes after dusk. The pavilion has been reserved for every weekend through August, and there are plans for a second pavil-

ion. The county is also working with Morehead State University's cross-country staff to develop a cross-country trail within the park, and the public is invited to the park's Sunday Funday on May May 17, which will included a dedication of the courts and playground, at 1 p.m.

Board member Wes Holland called the county park "a home run."

The next Recreation Board meeting will be May 12.
