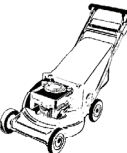

PROPOSED TAX NOTIFICATION

The Breathitt County Board of Education is proposing a general fund tax levy of 68.4 cents on real property and 68.4 cents on personal property.

The General Fund tax levied in fiscal year 2025-2026 was 68.4 cents on real property and 68.4 cents on personal property and produced revenue of \$2,533,161.07.

The proposed General Fund tax rate of 68.4 cents on real property and 68.4 cents on personal property is expected to produce \$2,656,845.18. Of this amount, \$532,503.88 is from new and personal property.

The compensating tax rate for 2027 is 65.8 cents on real property and 68.4 cents on personal property and is expected to produce \$2,575,284.10.

The proposed rate is expected to generate more revenue than received in the preceding year. The general areas to which revenue of \$81,561.08 above 2026 revenue is to be allocated are as follows: Cost of collections, \$3,262.44; building fund, \$0; instruction, \$78,298.64; transportation, \$0; and maintenance of plant, \$0.

The Kentucky River Area Development District (KRADD), located in Hazard, Kentucky, on behalf of the City of Jackson, is seeking qualified contractors to provide consultation on a raw water source feasibility study for the Jackson Raw Water Alternative Source Study, located at Panbowl Lake, Jackson, Kentucky.

This project will study the feasibility of using Panbowl Lake as a primary or secondary source of raw water. The study will include water quality testing, evaluation of lake recharge rates, and review of regulatory restrictions. Additional alternative raw water sources will also be explored. Based on the study findings, a project scope and preliminary cost estimates will be developed for implementation.

This project is anticipated to be funded in whole or in part through Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC). Contract award and project implementation are contingent upon funding availability and compliance with applicable federal, state, and local requirements.
