ROBERTA MAE "BERTIE" (KELLEY) MCQUILLEN



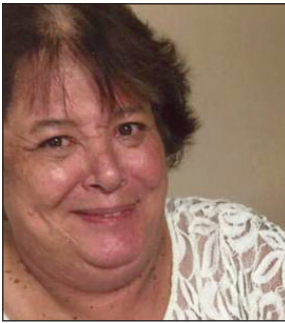
