## LEGAL NOTICE AMENDED WATER RATE ORDINANCE **CITY OF HANSON**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-5-7** 

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF HANSON KENTUCKY AMENDING RATE FEE AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATERWORKS SYSTEM PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH RATES, FEE, AND CHARGES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Hanson, Kentucky has heretofore determined that the promotion and preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare of said city and all of its citizens and inhabitants requires the maintenance and operation of a municipal waterworks system, and

WHEREAS it is necessary that rates and charges for services provided by the municipal waterworks system provide for the payment for interest, principal, operating expenses, and maintenance, and

WHEREAS it is necessary at this time that a new schedule of rates be prescribed in that provision be made for collection thereof, NOW THEREFORE, the city of Hanson, Kentucky, ordain as follows:

### SECTION 1. WATER CONNECTION CHARGES

A waterworks connection charge shall be assessed for each connection to the waterworks system as follows:

ALL METERS \$1500.00

Along with any excessive expense borne by the city to provide such service including road boars.

SECTION 2. METER DEPOSITS

a. Meter deposits for property located inside the City Limits.

In addition to connection charges as aforesaid, all customers for owner occupied property shall pay a meter deposit of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) to the City for water services before such customers shall be entitled to such service. Customers for non-owner-occupied property shall pay a deposit of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00) before such customer shall be entitled to such service. Such deposit, less any unpaid charges, shall be refunded to the customer, his/her heirs or assigns, whenever such customer notifies the City to legally disconnect or terminate service to customer.

b. Meter deposits for property located outside the City Limits.

In addition to connection charges as aforesaid, all customers for owner occupied property shall pay a meter deposit of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) to the City for water service before such customers shall be entitled to such service. Customers for non-owner-occupied property shall pay a deposit of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00) before such customers shall be entitled for such service. Such deposit, less any unpaid charges, shall be refunded to the customer, his/her heirs or assigns, whenever such customer notifies the City legally to disconnect or terminate service to such customer.

#### SECTION 3. WATER TURN ON FEE

In addition to connection charges and meter deposits as aforesaid, there shall be charged to all waterworks customers an initial turn on fee of FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00).

#### SECTION 5. BILLING, COLLECTION, AND PENALTIES:

The rates or charges aforesaid shall be billed monthly, on statements which shall be issued on or about the first of each month, and all bills for such services shall be considered due and payable TEN (10) days after the date of issue, such bill shall be considered delinquent, and there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid, in an amount equal to 10% of the charges (other than sales tax) shown on the face amount of such delinquent bill. The city may serve a customer written notice of the delinquency. If such bill is not paid withing TEN (10) days after mailing of such notice, the city may disconnect the water service of such customer without further notice. If water service is disconnected by the city by reason of delinquency in the payment of any water bill, reconnection of such service shall not be made until the owner or user pays all charges and penalties owed, plus the amount of SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$65.00) as a disconnection and reconnection charge. IF any deadline date falls on a Sunday or legal holiday, such deadline shall not expire until the next secular day thereafter.

The water rates herein established in Section 4 shall become effective on the 7th day of May 2024 and will be reflected on billing beginning the 24th day of May 2024.

ALL CITY ORDINANCE, ORDERS, RESOLUTIONS, MOTIONS, or parts thereof, insofar as the same may be in conflict herewith are repealed.

The foregoing ORDINANCE was read to and presented to a special called meeting of the City Commission of the City of Hanson, Kentucky for first reading on the 2" day of May 2024 and by special called meeting for the second reading on the 7th day of May 2024.
