

Former Cat elected to Madison HOF

Dominique Hawkins is now a Hall of Famer.

The former University of Kentucky standout, who led Madison Central to its only state championship in 2013 and was named Mr. Basketball following his senior season, was inducted into the Madison County Sports Hall of Fame Saturday night at Eastern Kentucky University.

Hawkins was one of nine individuals and three teams enshrined into the third class of inductees. Hawkins was joined by Phillis Adams, Keith Bosley, Jimmy Cain, Mike Elkin, Dr. Harold Moberly, Taryn Ignacio Patrick, Pat Stephens and J.W. "Spider" Thurman.

"This is amazing," Hawkins said following the ceremony "As a kid, you don't really think that you could be in a Hall of Fame for anything, whereas, you grind it out and just play ball and do the best as you can. You never know what happens. Nothing's impossible."

Following his prep career, Hawkins, 29, enjoyed a successful

four-year career with the Wildcats and was named Most Outstanding Player of the 2017 Southeastern Conference Tournament after scoring a career-high 14 points in Kentucky's 82-65 win over Arkansas.

Madison Central coach Allen Feldhaus joined Hawkins at the ceremony and wasn't surprised by Hawkins' induction into the prestigious Hall of Fame.

"Not only was he a great player, he was just such a good, good kid," said Feldhaus. "He is the most humble young man that I've ever coached."

Feldhaus also said Hawkins was unselfish and he often had to remind his former player to "shoot the basketball" at times when the Indians weren't playing a team "of our caliber."

"He'd want to get everybody else involved (and) he was always thinking about his teammates," he said. "But when we were playing against somebody, that was really good ... I would always send him a text (that said something like) the cream always rises the top in big games, a big time player — step up. Yes, sir. He knew when to take over."
