PUBLIC NOTICE ORDINANCE NO.2048

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE REGULATORY LICENSE FEE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF DANVILLE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 - 2026.

WHEREAS, the City of Danville, Kentucky (hereinafter "City") is authorized to impose a regulatory license fee on the sale of alcoholic beverages of each establishment therein licensed to sell alcoholic beverages pursuant to the KRS 243.075 and City of Danville Ordinance Section 2.5-19: and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the regulatory license fee revenues from the prior fiscal year as well as the expenditures related to the additional policing, regulatory and administrative expenses related to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City, with a copy of income statement being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and WHEREAS, the City finds that the current regulatory license fees are reasonably estimated to

somewhat reimburse the City for the additional policing, regulatory and administrative expenses related to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The regulatory license fee shall be five percent (5%) of gross sales of all alcoholic beverages sold by the drink. In the case of retail sales of package distilled spirits and wine, the regulatory license fee shall be four percent (5%) of gross sales. The regulatory license fee shall be three percent (5%) on gross retail sales of package malt beverages.

SECTION TWO: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason declared illegal, unconstitutional, or otherwise invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Ordinance is in conflict with provisions of existing Ordinances or laws, it is the intent of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Danville, Kentucky, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall govern, and such provisions in existing Ordinances or Laws in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
