These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for the activities to be undertaken by the City of Beattyville.

TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND PERSONS:

**Request for Release of Funds**

On or about August 26, 2025 the City of Beattyville will submit a request to the Department for Local Government for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) to undertake the following project:

**Water Treatment Plant Improvements Phase 2**

The Beattyville WTP Improvements Project Phase 2 will include improvements to the water treatment plant including coring of the filter media and a report, the installation of new tube settlers, adding 6 inches of Anthracite Filter Media to all filters, install 4 sluice gates in the flocculator walls, sludge removal equipment, automatic filter backwash system repairs, replacing solenoid valves on all the filters, and other misc. improvements. Extension of approximately 47,900 feet of 8" waterline from rock of ages to Zachariah along KY 11. This extension will also include a new duplex pump station at rock of ages, a 300,000-gallon elevated water storage tank, a new interconnect with Campton and other appurtenances. The existing Campton interconnection system at Big Andy will be improved by replacing the master meter components and rehabilitating the granny couch pump station.

**Finding of No Significant Impact**

The City of Beattyville has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) (PL-91190) is not required. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) respecting the project has been made by the City of Beattyville which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets forth the reasons why such a Statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is available upon request, at the Beattyville City Hall Office, 28 Railrd St PO Box 307, Beattyville, KY between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted.

**Public Comments**

All interested agencies, groups, and persons disagreeing with the ERR decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration to the City of Beattyville Office. Such written comments should be received at 28 Railrd St PO Box 307, Beattyville, KY 41311, or michael.smith@kradd.org on or before August 26, 2025. All comments received will be considered before authorizing the submission of a request for a release of funds or taking any administrative action on the project before the date specified in the proceeding sentence. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

**Environmental Certification**

The City of Beattyville will undertake the project described above with Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) funds from the Department for Local Government (DLG) under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The City of Beattyville is certifying to the state that the City of Beattyville and Edward Scott Jackson, in his official capacity as Mayor, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities concerning environmental reviews, decision-making, and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, the City of Beattyville may use the ARC funds, and the state and ARC will have satisfied their responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and related laws and authorities.

**Objection to Release of Funds**

The state will accept objections to its release of funds and the City of Beattyville certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission dates or its actual receipt for the request (whichever is the later) only if they are on one of the following bases:

- (a) The certification was not executed by the City of Beattyville Certifying Officer.
- (b) The City of Beattyville has failed to make one of the two findings according to S58.41 or to make the written determination decision required by SS578.57, 58.53, or 58.64 for the project, as applicable.
- (c) The City of Beattyville has omitted one or more of the steps outlined in Subparts F and G for the preparation and completion of an EA.
- (d) No opportunity was given to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation or its Executive Director to review the effect of the project on a property listed on the National Register of Historic Places or found to be eligible for such listing by the Secretary of the Interior, per 36 CFR Part 800.
- (e) The recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs, or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR part 58 before approval of the release of funds and approval of the Environmental Certification by HUD or the State.
- (f) Another Federal agency acting according to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality.

Objections must be prepared and submitted following the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Department for Local Government, Office of Federal Grants, 1024 Capital Center Drive, Ste. 340 Frankfort, Kentucky 40601.

Objections to the release of funds on bases other than those stated above will not be considered by the state. No objection received after August 26, 2025 will be considered by the state. Potential objectors should contact the Department for Local Government to verify the actual last day of the state Comment period.
