When Harrison County native Bobby Brannock came to town for a visit in late June, he arrived in an ID Buzz identical to the one in the commercial.

Bobby drove the all-electric vehicle to Cynthiana from Fort Collins, Colorado loaded down with Mary, four sons and a dog.

Counting a detour through Pigeon Forge to see the Titanic Museum (a couple of the boys are obsessed with the doomed ocean liner), he figures the drive to Cynthiana was about 1400 miles.

ID Buzz positivity at its best! A long trip in the all-electric vehicle is much different from one in a gasoline-powered car. It must be charged every 200 miles or so. Loaded down as

it was, the need to stop was low. more frequent. Bobby said they stopped four times a day, with each charge taking about half an hour.

"The vehicle does it," he said. Tell it where you're going and it knows where you'll need to stop and recharge. Sometimes charging stations are further apart and top off

Even in the busy summer vacation season, only once did they have to wait to get in Georgetown that will access to a charger. He change. acknowledged, however, worrying about the possibility of a charging station being out of order when he needed one, but that never happened.
