

# Grayson County tennis teams improve records

As the Grayson County Cougar tennis program's regular season comes to a close, players have kept busy with several matches held in recent weeks.

On April 26, both Grayson County's men's and women's teams shut out the visiting North Hardin 5-0.

That same day, Grayson County also hosted Daviess County. While the men's team defeated Daviess County 6-3, Grayson County's women's team fell 1-8.

The Cougars continued their winning ways and the Lady Cougars returned to the win column as they hosted Meade County on April 28. Grayson County's men's team won 5-0, and the women's team won 3-2.

Grayson County suffered a setback on May 1 as it hosted Owensboro Catholic, however. The men's team came up short to Owensboro Catholic 4-5, and the women's team also fell to the visitors 1-8.

Overall, Grayson County's men's team obtained a 16-3 positive record for the season, with two losses to Owensboro Catholic and one loss to Bowling Green.

Grayson County's women's team finished the regular season with a 13-5 positive record, with two losses to Owensboro Catholic and Daviess County and one loss to Bowling Green.


