Fiscal Court meets, approves County Priority Projects Program Resolution

Green County Fiscal Court, in its regular called monthly meeting, Thursday, July 17, approved Resolution No. 07-17-2025-02 regarding County Priority Projects Program (CPPP) funds.

"Green County will be receiving up to \$353,000 to resurface Doc Ward Road and Hall Cemetery Road. CPPP funds are now distributed by the Kentucky Legislature and we certainly appreciate their assistance," said Judge-Executive John Frank.

In other business, magistrates approved:

- (1) To authorize Judge-Executive Frank to execute agreement regarding CPPP funds;
- (2) The first reading of Budget Amendment No. 26001 with total amended revenues amounting to \$563,055.85;
- (3) The Green County Sheriff's 2024 Tax Settlement;
- (4) To authorize Judge Frank to sign Resolution No. 07-17-2025 pertaining to the

discontinuance and closure of a portion of Brushy Road, a distance of 411 feet;

(5) To pay eight percent to four county employees pertaining to the effective time period regarding health insurance;

(6) Shelley Bishop and Karen Buchanan Allen as Old Courthouse employees;

(7) To authorize Judge-Executive John Frank to sign an agreement for Rural and Municipal Aid/Flex Funds between the Green County Fiscal Court and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Transportation Cabinet, Department of Municipal Aid amounting to \$118,215;

(8) To authorize Judge-Executive Frank to sign a resolution adopting and approving the execution of the Rural Secondary Program Agreement between the Fiscal Court and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Transportation Cabinet, Department of Rural and Municipal Aid;

(9) To authorize Judge Frank to sign a contract and Memorandum of Agreement for HB1 Various Project funds amounting to \$2 mil-

lion;

(10) To re-appoint Park Board members Charles Jewell and Jacob Davis to two-year terms (Aug. 26, 2025-Aug. 25, 2027);

(11) The Statewide Emergency Management Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement;

(12) To authorize Judge-Executive John Frank to sign Resolution No. 07-17-2025-03 Statewide Emergency Management Mutual Aid;

(13) The Green County Emergency Management/Campbellsville Fire/Rescue Automatic Aid Agreement subject to approval by the E911 Board and the City of Greensburg;

(14) To pay Park Maintenance employee Pete Bell \$50 per week for seven weeks and thereafter, \$100 per week for six weeks to maintain ballfields at American Legion Park;

(15) To appoint Jerry Dile as a Tax Assessment Board member for a three-year term (Sept 1, 2025-Aug. 31, 2028);

Safe Haven Baby Box Project update


