for theft**

The Hancock County
grand jury indicted Can-
nelton, Indiana resident
Isaiah Castleberry on
four charges. The grand

jury accused Castleberry
of committing the offens-
es of theft by unlawful
taking or disposition-fire-
arm, theft by unlawful
taking from a vehicle,
and two counts of unlaw-
ful transaction with a mi-
nor second degree.

Castleberry stands
accused of committing
these offenses on or
about February 16, 2024.
The court set his bail at
\$25,000.00, and his ar-
raignment is November
22, 2024, at 10 am.

**Dickens indicted for
sexual abuse**

The Hancock Coun-
ty grand jury indicted
Hawesville resident Wil-
laim Dickens on three
charges. The grand
jury accused Dickens of
committing the offens-
es of procure or promote
use of electronic means
to induce a minor to en-
gage in sexual activity,

sexual abuse in the first
degree-victim under 12
years or age, and per-
sistent felony offender in
the second degree.

Dickens stands ac-
cused of committing
these offenses between
May 1, 2024, and July 24,
2024. The court set his
bail \$100,000.00, and his
arraignment is Novem-
ber 22, 2024, at 10 am.

**Conway indicted on
abuse charges**

The Hancock Coun-
ty grand jury indicted
Hawesville resident Amy
Conway on two charges.
The grand jury accused
the offenses of criminal
abuse in the first de-
gree-child 12 or under,
and two counts of tam-
pering with witness.

Conway stands ac-
cused of committing
these offenses between
January 6, 2020, and
January 5, 2022. The
court set her bail at
\$25,000.00, and his ar-
raignment is November
22, 2024, at 10 am.

**Hill indicted for sex
charges**

The Hancock Coun-
ty grand jury indicted

Granville, Ohio resident
Nathan Hill on four
charges. The grand jury
accused Hill of commit-
ting the offenses of four
counts of sodomy in the
first degree-victim un-
der 12 years of age, un-
lawful use of electronic
means to induce a mi-
nor to engage in sexual
activity, distribution of
obscene material to a
minor, and persistent
felony offender in the
second degree.

Hill stands accused
of committing these
offenses between Jan-
uary 6, 2018, and
January 5, 2021. The
court set his bail at
\$250,000.00, and his
arraignment is Novem-
ber 22, 2024, at 10 am.

**Green indicted for
flagrant nonsupport**

Louisville, Kentucky
resident Kaelin Green
was indicted by the
Hancock County grand
jury on one charge.
Green stands accused of
committing the offense
of flagrant nonsupport.

The court set her bail
at \$11,000.00, and her
arraignment is Novem-
ber 22, 2024 at 10 am.
