on an irreversible outcome that is determined by chance. Disordered gambling is classified as an addictive behavior by the American Psychiatric Association in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of the Mental Disorders.

Disordered gambling is an addictive behavior that impacts more than 60,000 Kentuckians according to survey results. The survey indicates more than 165,000 Kentuckians have a gambling problem. Disordered gamblers affect 8-10 others. They cost society an estimated \$9,000 annually by each disordered gambler for expenses from social services,

domestic abuse, unemployment, lost wages and productivity, criminal justice and bankruptcy. Disordered gamblers have the highest suicide rate among all addictive disorders.

Two events are scheduled in Kentucky during Problem Gambling Awareness Month.

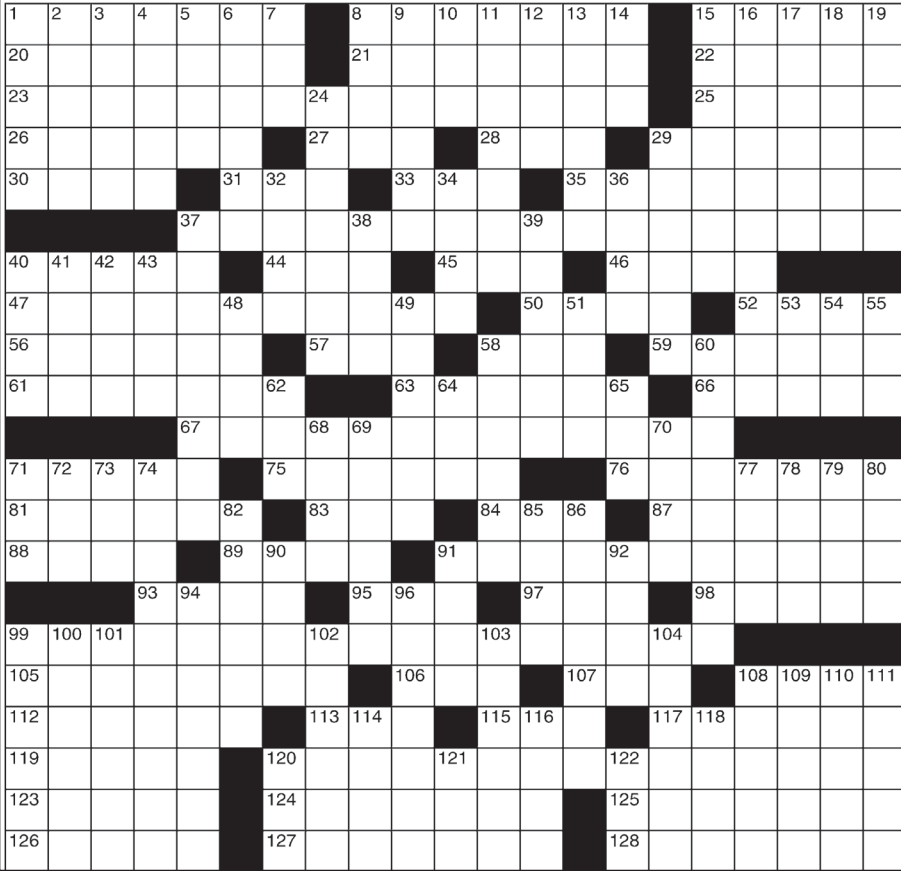
March 11, 2025, is Gambling Disorder Screening Day. Behavioral health and medical practitioners will raise awareness and educate about problem and disordered gambling at their offices, clinics and practices.
