ORDINANCE NO 2024-2025-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCE 2024-2025-01 AMENDING THE CITY OF EDMONTON 12 MONTH BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

BY REVISING APPROPRIATION ESTIMATES TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS OF THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE CITY OF EDMONTON.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONTON, KENTUCKY

SECTION 1:
That the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025 is hereby amended as follows:
(a) Increase the estimated appropriation fund balance of the General Fund of the City by \$35,000.00 from \$3,054,334 to \$3,089,334. Senior Center Renovation
(b) Increase the estimated appropriation fund balance of the General Fund of the City by \$9,717.00 from \$3,089,334 to \$3,099,051. Edmonton Memorial Park HV AC & Signage
(c) Increase the estimated appropriation fund balance of the General Fund of the City by \$8,740.00 from \$3,099,051 to \$3,107,791. Senior Center HVAC
(d) Increase the estimated appropriation fund balance of the General Fund of the City by \$7,314.00 from \$3,107,791 to \$3,115,105. Chamber of Commerce HVAC
(e) Increase the estimated appropriation fund balance of the General Fund of the City by \$17,000 from \$3,115,105 to \$3,132,105. City Legal Expense-Open Records Request
(f) Increase the estimated appropriation fund balance of the General Fund of the City by \$3,000 from \$3,132,105 to \$3,135,105. Police Department- Contract Labor-City Hall Security

SECTION 2:
That this ordinance shall be in effect upon passage and publication.

Second reading - June 6, 2025
