2025 PROPOSED TAX RATE **PUBLIC HEARING**

The Lincoln County Fiscal Court will hold a public hearing on August 26, 2025, at 9:00 am at the Lincoln County Veterans Park Wellness Center on Goshen Rd, Stanford, for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The tax levied last year was .094 and produced revenues of \$1.150.742 in revenues. This year's compensating rate is .087 and will produce \$1,185,041. The Lincoln County Fiscal Court proposes a tax rate of .09 which will produce a total of \$1,225,905 in revenues.

Revenue expected from New Property is \$19548; revenue expected from Personal Property is \$188,295; revenues expected from Motor Vehicle is \$292,675; and revenue expected from Watercraft is \$10,022.

The Lincoln County Fiscal Court is currently accepting bids to construct a mezzanine-style conveyor/sorting system built to fit the existing facility

- 64-foot sorting line (8) 20 by 24-inch drop slots 24-inch-wide belt line 24-inch-high backsplash

The purpose of the Project is to ensure the continued safe and reliable operation of the Station by replacing the existing units at the Station, while continuing to meet all currently applicable air emissions requirements. Texas Eastern as a part of the Danville Compressor Station Replacement Project is proposing upgrades to the Danville facility to optimize and strengthen our existing infrastructure network. Texas Eastern respectfully requests the Commission issue an order granting the authorizations requested by June 30, 2026 to allow Texas Eastern to complete and place the Project facilities into service by May 1, 2028. Specifically, Texas Eastern proposes to

 Replacement of 7 reciprocating units and 3 natural gas-fired turbines with three new natural gasfired turbines.

The Project will also include all the associated piping, building, construction, and removal as necessarv.
