Matchups are set for 2026 World **Baseball** Classic

World Baseball Classic, Inc. on Wednesday announced the four pools for the 20-team tournament and thus the bracketing for how the multiround event will unfold in 2026.

Miami's loanDepot park, home of the Miami Marlins, will once again play an integral role in the tournament by hosting in every phase of the event pool play, quarterfinals, semifinals and the championship.

For the Miami portion of the tournament, action begins with pool play from March 6-11, with loanDepot park hosting a fiveteam field of Venezuela, the Dominican Republic, the Netherlands, Israel and Nicaragua. The teams will play in a round-robin format, with each team playing the remaining four teams in the pool.

The top two teams from the Miami bracket, Pool D, will advance to the quarterfinals on March 13 and 14 to face the two teams that advance from Pool C, a group that consists of Japan, Australia, Korea, Czechia and Chinese Taipei and will begin the tournament in Tokyo. The Pool D winner will face the Pool C runner-up, and the Pool C winner will face the Pool D runner-up.

The semifinals will be on March 15 and 16, with the championship set for March 17.

The other half of the bracket is as follows: Pool A, in San Juan,

Yankees' Judge to captain Team USA in 2026 WBC

New York Yankees slugger Aaron Judge will play for Team USA at the 2026 World Baseball Classic and serve as the squad's captain.

Manager Mark DeRosa made the announcement Monday on MLB Network. Judge is the first player to be named to the team.

The two-time American League MVP did not participate in the 2023 global

competition, in which then-captain Mike Trout and the U.S. team lost to the Shohei Ohtani-led Japan team in the goldmedal game.

Judge, 32, expressed his desire to compete in the 2026 WBC during spring training.

"I think that would be pretty fun," the outfielder told Fox Sports on Feb. 19. "It just depends. See where I'm at in my career at that point. Hopefully they still want me."

Judge never has participated in the international event, which runs from March 5-17, 2026. Games will take place in Houston, Miami, Tokyo and San Juan, Puerto Rico, with the semifinals and championship game in Miami.

"It would be cool to represent your country," Judge said. "(Team USA) made it to the finals, but they didn't win it. So we gotta win it. We'll see. We'll see."
