PUBLIC NOTICE SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING KRS 45A.730 to 45A.750 RELATING TO PROCUREMENT OF ARCHITEC-TURAL AND ENGINEER-ING SERVICES FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS AND ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR DESIGN-BUILD A N D PUB-LIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP PROCURE-MENT ON CAPI-TAL PROJECTS WHEREAS, KRS 45A.735 authorizes

counties to adopt the provisions of KRS 45A.740, 45A.745, and 45A.750, "Procurement of Architectural and Engineering Services" as an alternative method for procuring architectural and engineering services; and WHEREAS, KRS 65.025 and KRS 65.028 additionally establish standards for design-build capital projects and the public-private partnership delivery method for awarding capital construction project contracts; and

WHEREAS, Clay County desires to implement these additional procurement options, ARCHITECTURAL aligning the County's project delivery methods with the growing industry practice of utilizing the design-build construction method and public-private partnerships to decrease costs and project timelines, while increasing project quality.
