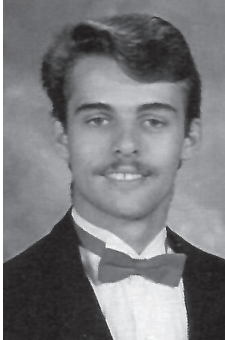
Miss W.H.S.

All interested participants must register with the County Clerk’s office by the close of business on July 6, 2025. Taxpayers can continue to pay their delinquent tax bills to the County Clerk’s office anytime prior to the tax sale. **Please Note: All payments must be received in the County Clerk’s office prior to the tax sale date listed in this advertisement. Payments received after the sale date has been conducted will be returned without exception.** Some delinquencies — although they have been advertised — will be excluded from the tax sale in accordance with the provisions of KRS 134.504(10)(b).
