Lady Cougars host youth camp

Youth camp tries to inspire the next generation of basketball talent

On Friday, as the school year ended and the summer started, the Logan County Lady Cougars basketball program opened up their gym to host a youth summer camp session for girls interested in learning the game of basketball. An opportunity for the program


to connect with its community, reach out to its next generation of players, and teach and mentor kids that want to learn the sport and find their passion. It was a successful day led by the Lady Cougars head coach Dedra Adler, and her “coaching staff” of current varsity players, including Brenley Adler, Addison Holloway, Reese Wet-

ton, Avery Thompson, Alissa Hampton, Reece Bush, and several others, and a former Lady Cougars star, Gracie Borders. For the first session, it was kindergarten through 3rd grade, as they focused on basic fundamentals of basketball. Rotating in different stations, teaching the girls how to dribble the basketball, how to shoot a layup,

and how to pass the ball. A big game of Sharks & Minnows was another fun teaching tool to teach the skill of keeping away from players while dribbling the ball through the court. During the second session, the older group consisted of fourth graders to sixth graders and the skill drills were ramped up to a higher level.

After warm-ups, the focus was on ball-handling moves such as the hesitation, the behind-the-back, the crossover, and the back pivot. Then, as the rotations took place, each of the coaches was teaching different layups around the rim. The two-foot layup, finishing layups with both the left hand and the
