

Eagle fishers compete in March 29 tourney

Ohio County High School's bass fishing team had four boats compete in a the MLF Open tournament March 29 at Kentucky-Barkley Lake at Gilbertsville. A total of 81 boats were entered in the one-day affair, with 58 of those recording scores.

Jess Stevens' anglers are scheduled to compete in a "practice" tournament this Saturday, April 12, at Lake Barkley on the same waters that will host the Region One championship on April 26. Hancock County High School will host the Hancock Open the week before at the same site in a final tuneup for the regional.

Muhlenberg County's duo of Levi Simms and Karson Stone took first in the March 29 tourney,

catching five fish weighing in at 18 pounds three ounces, beating the second-place team by nearly four pounds. Ohio County's top team on the day was Kash Black and Hunter Embry who placed 13th on three fish weighing eight pounds nine ounces.

The OCHS duo of Tommy Martin and Zander Naue took 31st on one fish weighing four pounds eight ounces.
