Firewood permits now available for online purchase

WINCHESTER, Ky., May 5 — Firewood permits for the Daniel Boone National Forest are now available for purchase through a new online E-Permit system. E-permits may be purchased by computer or mobile device at any time which eliminates travel to your local Forest Service office.

“The new E-Permit system will help streamline the firewood permit process for our public,” said Daniel Boone National Forest Deputy Forest Supervisor Brad Turberville. “Our district offices will continue to issue firewood permits in-person, but I imagine that many folks will be excited to use the new system and avoid the trip to an office.”

This new service provides flexibility and convenience to our forest users. Traditional firewood permits will still be available to purchase in-person at local Forest Service offices.
