REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE POSITION OF MAINTENANCE WORKER

The City of Campton is currently accepting applications for the position of Maintenance Worker. The duties of the position include general maintenance activities related to the sewer lines, water lines, upkeep of city streets, the Campton city park, roads, alleys, sidewalks, storm sewers, manholes, culverts, drainage ditches, street signs and other city areas and property. The employee will work under the general supervision of the Maintenance Department Supervisor; the Campton City Commission and the Mayor.

All applicants need to have a valid drivers license in order to be considered. Applicants need to possess a high school degree or equivalency. Previous work in a similar position is preferred but not required. A detailed job description of the position may be obtained from the Campton City Office upon request. The rate of pay shall be based upon the City of Campton's pay scale, as well as the applicant's work history and training which the applicant may have. The rate of pay is negotiable based on the experience and qualifications of the applicant.

Any full time employee of the City of Campton is eligible for retirement and health insurance benefits through the City following the completion of an initial introductory period of employment. Applications should be picked up at the Campton City Office during regular business hours. Massive solar energy project eyed for neighboring East Kentucky counties

July 15 — A new coalition is coming together to create opportunities for shared learning and dialogue as the largest solar farm in Kentucky is planned for construction on the historic Starfire Mine site, which spans parts of Breathitt, Knott, Perry, and Floyd counties.

BrightNight, the power and digital infrastructure company, is in the development phase of a proposed solar energy project known as Starfire Solar. The Starfire surface coal mine has been mined for decades and much of it is now reclaimed mine land serving as pastureland and wildlife habitat. The Starfire Solar project will be constructed in up to four phases on the surface of this reclaimed mine land. The first phase of 210 MW will be constructed on approximately 1,385 acres at the intersection between Breathitt, Knott, and Perry Counties. During later phases, a new transmission line may cross into Floyd County. The project is expected to commence construction in 2026. As the project advances through the regulatory process, local residents are working to ensure that the economic benefits reach the

surrounding communities.

The Starfire Community Coalition was launched in April 2025, formed through the Community Foundations in Breathitt, Perry, Knott, and Floyd counties which support small businesses, fight food and housing insecurity, and many other community-led initiatives. Each Foundation is led by a volunteer, non-political board with a deep track record of supporting grassroots non-profit work in Eastern Kentucky. The coalition's mission is to open conversations about how solar development can best serve local people—and to learn alongside BrightNight and other stakeholders what a Community Benefits Agreement (CBA) might look like in this context.

"Our coalition is interested in learning from similar projects across the country and understanding how tools like CBAs can support fair local hiring, job training, and other long-term community investments," said representatives from the Starfire Community Coalition. "We see this as an invitation—for our communities and BrightNight—to

explore what's possible when we work together to shape a shared future."

BrightNight has already taken early steps toward community investment, including a commitment to annual contributions to the Foundation for Appalachian Kentucky via a non-donor advised fund that will support community-led priorities.

The coalition is focused on making this a two-way learning process. As they continue to engage with local organizations, residents, and workers, they aim to better understand the region's hopes, needs, and ideas for how this solar project can support a stronger, more resilient Appalachian Kentucky.

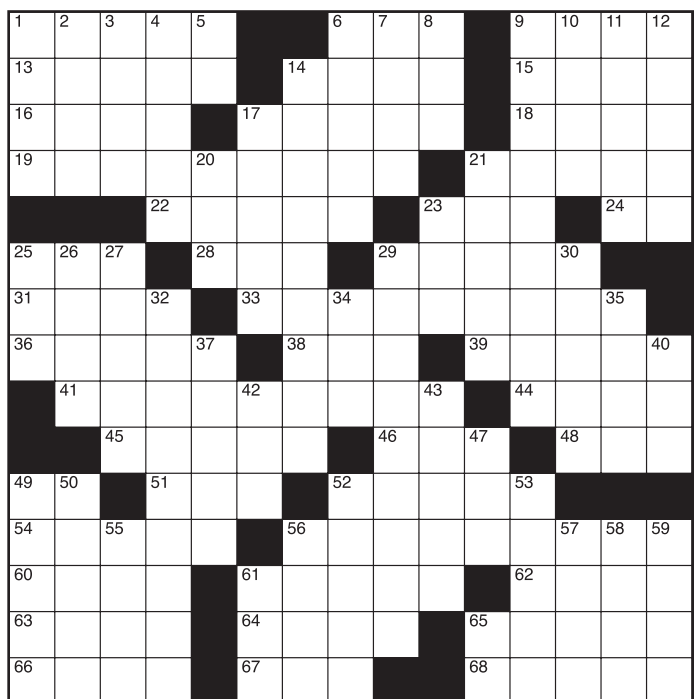
