Request for Release of Funds

On or about March 14, 2025, the Caldwell County Fiscal Court will submit a request to the Department for Local Government for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) to undertake the following project:

#### Finding of No Significant Impact

The Caldwell County Fiscal Court has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) (PL-91-190) is not required. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

# **Environmental Certification**

The Caldwell County Fiscal Court will undertake the project Local Government under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The Caldwell County Fiscal Court is certifying to the state that William Dakota Young, in his official capacity as Judge Executive, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews. decision making, and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval Caldwell County Fiscal Court may use the Block Grant funds and the state and HUD will have satisfied their responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and related laws and authorities.

- No opportunity was given to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation or its Executive Director to review the effect of the project on a property listed on the National Register of Historic Places or found to be eligible for
- The recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR part 58 before approval of the release of funds and approval of the Environmental Certification by HUD or the
- Another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental
