ORDINANCE 07-08-2025-01
Caldwell County Fiscal Court
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF CALDWELL COUNTY
WHEREAS, the 2025 Kentucky General Assembly passed Senate Bill 63 (2025 Ky. Acts Chapter 89, hereinafter "the Act"), which allows for the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on certain highways and roadways within the Commonwealth of Kentucky if authorized by ordinance of the local government within whose jurisdictional boundaries such a public way is located; and **WHEREAS**, the Act became effective on June 27, 2025; and **WHEREAS**, the Caldwell County Fiscal Court wishes to take advantage of the home-rule authority granted in said legislation, and allow for the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on certain public ways within the unincorporated area of Caldwell County in accordance with the Act and the provisions of this Ordinance. **NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Caldwell County Fiscal Court as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions
A. The definitions as set forth in Section 1, subsection (1) of 2025 Ky. Acts Chapter 89 (hereinafter "the Act"), and as may be amended from time to time by the Kentucky General Assembly, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if set out in full herein.
SECTION 2. Designated Highways
A. Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall be allowed, to the extent permitted by the Act, on all public highways and roadways, or portions thereof, that are located within the unincorporated area of Caldwell County, and maintained and/or under the control of the Caldwell County Fiscal Court or Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, where the speed limit is fifty-five (55) miles per hour or less.
SECTION 3. Compliance with Federal and State Law
A. Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, the operation of a street-legal special purpose vehicle on a public way in the unincorporated area of Caldwell County shall at all times comply in all respects with any applicable federal and/or state law, statute, rule or regulation, as may be currently in effect, and as may be promulgated or amended from time to time, including, but not limited to, those establishing minimum and required operator, safety, insurance and registration requirements.
SECTION 4. Violations
A. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per incident, in addition to any other penalties that may be imposed pursuant to federal and/or state law.
SECTION 5: Jurisdictional Applicability
A. The provisions and authorities contained and granted herein shall only apply within the unincorporated area of Caldwell County.
SECTION 6: Severability
A. If any provision contained herein is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unconstitutional, or otherwise unenforceable, such a determination shall not affect or impair the enforceability of the remaining provisions.
SECTION 7: Effective Date
A. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 03 – 2025
PUBLICATION SUMMARY**

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES ON LYON COUNTY ROADS AND HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the Lyon County Fiscal Court has determined that it is appropriate to allow the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on specified highways within the jurisdictional boundaries of Lyon County in accordance with the Act and this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LYON COUNTY FISCAL COURT, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE – DEFINITIONS
As used in this Ordinance:
"Street-legal special purpose vehicle" means a special purpose vehicle that meets the requirements of this section and is equipped with all of the following:
One (1) or more headlamps;
One (1) or more tail lamps;
One (1) or more brake lamps;
A trail lamp or other lamp constructed and placed to illuminate the registration plate with a white light;
One (1) or more red reflectors on the rear of the vehicle;
An amber electric turn system, one (1) on each side of the front of the vehicle;
Amber or red electric turn signals on the rear of the vehicle;
A braking system, other than a parking brake;
A horn or other warning device;
A working muffler that meets the requirements of KRS §189.140;
A steering wheel;
Rearview mirrors on the right and left side of the driver;
A windshield, unless the operator of the vehicle wears eye protection while operating the vehicle;
A speedometer, illuminated for nighttime operation;
A roll bar or roll cage sufficient to support the vehicle's weight;
For multi-passenger vehicles, a seatbelt assembly that conforms to the federal motor vehicle safety standard provided in HYPER-LINK

Tires that have at least two thirty-seconds (2/32) of an inch or greater tire tread.
"Street-legal special purpose vehicle" does not include a low-speed vehicle as defined in

SECTION TWO – DESIGNATED HIGHWAYS
Lyon County permits the operation of Street-legal special purpose vehicles by licensed operators to operate on roads and highways that are located within the jurisdictional limits of Lyon County where the speed limit is 55 miles per hour or less.

SECTION FOUR – REGISTRATION, INSURANCE AND RECIPROCIITY
A Street-legal special purpose vehicle operating on a public roadway under this Ordinance shall be:

Registered in accordance with KRS§ 186.020;

Insured in compliance with KRS §304.39-080 in the same amounts set forth in KRS §304.39-110 for motorcycles by the owner or operator, and the proof of insurance shall be inside the Street-legal special purpose vehicle at all times of operation on a public roadway; and

Comply with all other requirements in KRS Chapter 186.

Lyon County recognizes and grants reciprocity for registration of Street-legal special purpose vehicles that are properly licensed in other states, so long as the Street-legal special purpose vehicle meets the equipment requirements set forth in Section One (3) above.
