



Jackets defeat Augusta in the 1st round, lose to GRC in 2nd round

The Nicholas County Bluejackets, under Head Coach Spencer Morris, defeated the Augusta Panthers, 73-66, in the first round of the 2025 10th Region Boys Basketball Tournament, held on Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at Montgomery County High School, in Mt. Sterling, Kentucky.

The Jackets District Championship win against Harrison County was their first District Championship win in 25 years, while their win over Augusta was their first Region Tourney win in 33 years!!!

With that win, the Jackets advanced to the



Members of the Nicholas County Fire Protection District Board, including Chief Doug French, met on Tuesday, March 11, 2025, at 6:00pm, at the Nicholas County Fire Station, for their regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

The meeting was called to order with roll call, with only one board member absent. The board



approved the minutes of last month's meeting, the Treasurer's report, and Chief's Report.

Chief French reports that the department had a total of 13 runs last month, including 5 motor vehicle accidents, 5 weather related calls, 1 lift assist, 1 rescue, and 1 alarm drop. The chief said that it was a busy month, but that there were no fires.

Under old business, Chief French gave an update regarding Station 3, and that they were getting very close to opening the new station. He also said that there had been
