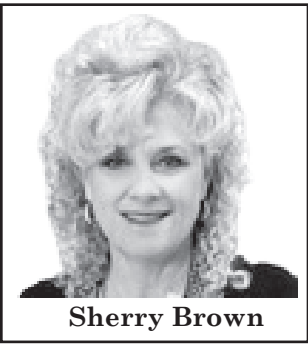

He reigned as the undisputed champion

at cruiserweight in the late 1980s and at heavyweight in the early 1990s, and is the only boxer in history to win the undisputed championship in two weight classes in the three belt era. Nicknamed "the Real Deal", Holyfield is the only four-time world heavyweight champion, having held the unified WBA, WBC, and IBF titles from 1990 to 1992, the WBA and IBF titles again from 1993 to 1994, the WBA title a third time from 1996 to 1999; the IBF title a third time from 1997 to 1999 and the WBA title for a fourth time from 2000 to 2001. has impacted his character, Holyfield said he would often “ask the Holy Spirit” to point out where he has been off the mark. “I learned to talk to the Holy Spirit.. ask ‘what do I do about this?’.. I found that useful.. going back to the father and asking him where I’ve gone wrong,” he said. The champion boxer went on to address the famous “ear-biting” incident with Mike Tyson, insisting that it was “easy to forgive” the heavyweight champion for the vicious attack. “You won’t be forgiven unless you forgive,” Evander warned. “I realized that I needed to be forgiven.” “God wants you to forgive.” A wise man and woman knows that true happiness and success is not that of any achievements in this world but by what is richly obtained through Christ salvation lifestyle and his kingdom attributes. The steel tank is a 11'x17' dimension with a 12,000 gallon capacity. The guy I bought it from in 2023 had liquid feed in it when I got it. I cleaned it up to where I was going to be fine using it for everything except fuel. It could be cleaned up for fuel yet too but I already had another fuel tank that sufficed so I never pursued and never actually used it for fertilizers either. It comes with the valves and pump pictured. He ensured me they all worked but I never tested any of it and would expect it to need cleaned up etc before using. We messed up the sight tube ports when we moved it home so that will need reworked. The main port will be fine if the threads are brushed out etc. We turned the valve off of it fine but it's been sitting for 3 years now.
