CITY OF MOUNT OLIVET ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHING A JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION, AND THEREBY ABOL ISHING THE IOINT PLANNING COMMISSION OF ROBERTSON COUNTY AND THE CITY OF MOUNT OLIVET

WHEREAS, the Robertson County Fiscal Court along with the Mount Olivet City Council, in 2010 (which could not be located of record as executed) both agreed and passed a joint planning commission, and thereafter in 2023 sought to ratify and re-establish such planning commission, and WHEREAS, both parties are now aware that joint planning commissions consist-

ing of one County and one City must have equal representation on the planning commission pursuant to applicable law, and WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of establishing a planning commission with equal representation of members from the County and from the City of Mount

Olivet, and otherwise fully complying with applicable laws regarding formation of NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MOUNT OLIVET, KENTUCKY that any and all previous ordinances which established a joint plan-

ning commission are hereby repealed, and the previous joint planning commission as established in 2010 and 2023 is hereby abolished. Adopted by the City Council of the City of Mount Olivet, on the date indicated below.
