came with them. Their connection with this area, particularly Bullitt and Nelson counties and the land on which Bernheim Forest is located, is much less known.
Some robberies in Kentucky:
April 29, 1872: Jesse James's gang robbed the Deposit Bank of Columbia, killing an unarmed cashier.
September 3, 1880:

They held up a stagecoach on the road from Mammoth Cave to Cave City.
Russellville Bank Robbery: The Russellville bank robbery is re-enacted every year at the Logan County Tobacco and Heritage Festival.
Alleged Hideouts:
Southern Kentucky legends say the James-Younger gang fled to Lost River Cave and others in

the Mammoth Cave system to nurse their injuries after a crime.
