WAY STREET TO A ONE-WAY STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MOUNT OLIVET, KENTUCKY as follows: NOW WHEREAS, McDowell Street, which runs between US 62 and Crescent Drive, is currently open to two way traffic, and

WHEREAS, the Mount Olivet City Council has determined that McDowell Street is no longer wide enough to support two-way traffic and that therefore the entirety of such street should be restricted to one-way traffic only, NOW THEREFORE.

1. McDowell Street shall no longer be available and open to two-way traffic, but instead shall hereby be made available and open to one-way traffic only, and motor vehicles on McDowell Street shall be permitted to travel in one lane only and head-ing in the one-way direction from Crescent Drive to US 62.

2. Proper and adequate signage shall be installed on and around McDowell Street to indicate this new traffic pattern before this Ordinance becomes effective, and citizens shall also be notified of such change via any City of Mount Olivet Social Media pages.
