NICHOLAS COUNTY PVA

Did you know about Kentucky's Homestead Exemption? The Homestead Exemption, based on age or disability, allows taxpayers who are 65 years of age or who are totally disabled to receive an exemption that is deducted off your total taxable assessment. This lowers the taxable value by a set amount, therefore, lowering your property tax bill.

The following requirements must be met to claim the homestead exemption:

1. The taxpayer must own and maintain the property as their primary residence as of January 1st.
2. The taxpayer must be 65 or turning 65 during the current tax year, OR
3. The taxpayer must have been classified as totally disabled under a program authorized or administered by an agency of the United States Government, including military, or any retirement system on January 1st for the year in which the application is made and maintain the disability classification through December 31st. The taxpayer must be receiving disability payments pursuant to that disability classification.

* The most common government agency under which a taxpayer can obtain a totally disabled classification is Social Security / SSI. Other programs include Veteran's Affairs and the Teacher's retirement System.

How to Apply: An application must be completed and filed in the PVA's office along with documentation verifying age. Appropriate documentation might include Medicare cards issued by Social Security, birth certificates, and driver's license. When applying for the disability homestead, the same form will apply. However, documentation verifying total disability (like awards letter) and that payments have been issued throughout the entire year must follow. Because of this, a taxpayer needs to provide proof of his or her disability status for the month of December of the previous year.
