states that during Dec. 1, 2024, thru Dec. 31, 2024, in Nicholas County, Kentucky, Ms. Nowling unlawfully engaged in abusive contact toward and against her minor child, as she arranged and authorized that her child, at age 13 years, receive a significant, permanent tattoo on his arm. The tattoo was applied/given by her paramour at the time, Mr. Joshua Overstreet, who has also been charged with Assault,

4th Degree (Child Abuse) for the incident, as well. The procedure was performed in an unhygienic environment.

Ms. Nowling was arrested and lodged in the Bourbon County Detention Center and late released on her own recognizance. She is scheduled for a pre-trial conference in Nicholas County District Court on Wednesday, Oct. 8, 2025, at 10:32am.

All persons are considered innocent until proven guilty or pleading guilty.

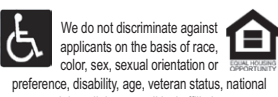

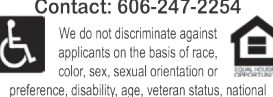

The 2025 Robertson County Property Tax Bills will be due and payable as of October 1, 2025. If you do not receive your tax bill by the second week of October, please contact the Robertson County Sheriff's Office at 606-724-5511. When mailing your payment please write your bill number on your check. If you wish for a receipt to be mailed back to you, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope. The Sheriff's Office mailing address is P.O. Box 365, Mt. Olivet, KY 41064. We accept cash, checks, cashier checks, money orders and credit cards (3% charge added to your payment).

2% Discount: 10/01/2025 to 11/01/2025
Face Value: 11/02/2025 to 12/31/2025
5% Penalty: 01/01/2026 to 01/31/2026
21% Penalty: 02/01/2026 to 04/15/2026

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please make sure that you are returning County Property Tax bills to the Sheriff's Office. The Robertson County Sheriff's Office does not collect tax bills for the City of Mt. Olivet. Please note that our office is located at 26 Court Street, Mt. Olivet, KY 41064.

All delinquent tax bills will be transferred to the County Clerk's Office at the end of the day on April 15, 2026. In addition to the penalties and fees that are applied by the Sheriff's Office, all payments made in the County Clerk's Office are subject to a 20% County Attorney's Fee, 20% County Clerk's Fee and interest at 1% per month. The delinquency is also subject to being sold to a third party in the summer of 2026.
