GREENUP - Sheriff Matt Smith has announced that the Greenup County Sheriff's Office will be conducting periodic traffic safety checkpoints throughout Greenup County as approved by the Greenup County Sheriff's Office policy and procedure manual. These checkpoints will be conducted in an effort to enforce the traffic laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. These locations can be found at Greenupso.com.

The Greenup County Sheriff's Office utilizes traffic safety checkpoints to promote safety for motorists using the public roadways and to provide a deterrent for those who violate laws contained in the Kentucky Revised Statutes, Smith said. FRANKFORT, – Gov. Andy Beshear announced that, thanks to approval by the federal government, healthy meals will continue to be provided to 450,000 Kentucky children while school is out.

Each eligible student will receive a one-time benefit of \$120 to purchase nutritious food throughout the summer. Support comes through the federal Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer Program, which began in 2024.

For families with students not automatically enrolled, applications are available until Aug. 15 at kysebt. ky.gov. Assistance is also available by calling the Department of Community Based Services at 855-306-8959 or by visiting a local office.
